Sisters in Action Meeting

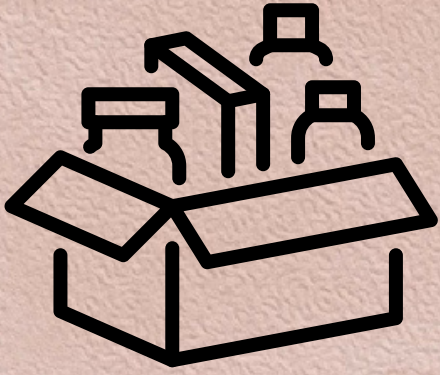
The Sisters in Action group will meet **Monday, April 8th** at **6:30 PM** in the CLC.

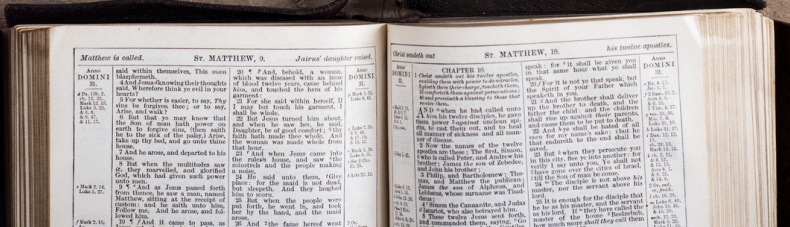
